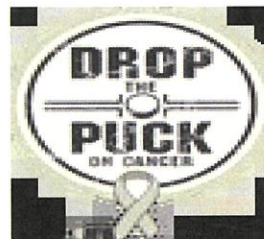

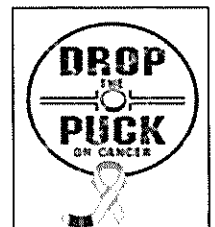

- **Reminder to put all your Officers & required Committees into the MMS.**

***** To give everyone a heads up. The \$8.00 per capita tax increase was passed at the Grand Aerie National Convention in New Orleans. I have been asked by many when the increase will take effect. June 1, 2025 or June 1,2026 per capita statement.**

The date of June 1, 2026, was brought to the floor as an ammendment and was defeated. All statute changes approved in New Orleans become effective immediately. The new Per Capita will be payable on June 1, 2025 per capita statement.

In order to help reduce costs, by booking flights sooner and taking the necessary steps to ensure all Aeries & Auxiliaries are in compliance, the Grand Aerie is making changes to the process for requesting Grand Aerie or Grand Auxiliary representatives for your events. Please help spread the word to any chairmen.

If you would like to request a Grand Representative to attend an event you will need to use the following guidelines.

1. Fill out the Representative Assignment Request form (attached) and send to Hope Mickle - hmickle@foe.com for an Auxiliary Representative or to Pete Samijlenko - petes@foe.com for an Aerie Representative.
 2. The form needs to be completely filled out and must be received 60 days prior to the event.
 3. Be in full compliance (see below) 45 days prior to the event.

 - Liquor Liability Insurance (Aerie Only) (if applicable)
 - Bond/Employee Dishonesty Coverage
 - Current Affiliation Agreement
 - Incorporated
 - Federal 990 for most recent Fraternal term
 - Auditor & Treasurers Reports
 - House Rules submitted to the Grand Aerie (Aerie only)
 - Delinquent (over 30 days past due and over \$100.00) (unless on a payment plan)
 - Officers listed in MMS
- MMS Aerie Appointed committees
 - MMS Auxiliary Appointed committees

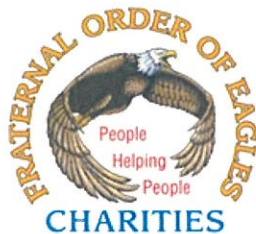
